### ALLERGEN STATEMENT

This essential oil is derived from Indian Sandalwood (*Santalum album* L.) and contains naturally occurring fragrance allergens as defined under EU Cosmetics Regulation 1223/2009. The following regulated allergen has been identified by GC-FID analysis and is present above declarable thresholds for both leave-on and rinse-off cosmetic products:

All other major constituents — including (Z)- $\beta$ -santalol (46.1%), (Z)- $\beta$ -santalol (18.4%), and (Z)-lanceol (2.0%) — are not listed on the EU regulated fragrance allergen list (EU Cosmetics Regulation 1223/2009, Annex III).

- Dilute to an appropriate level before topical application — not for use undiluted on skin.
